### Why Action is Needed Now

#### **High-Acuity Youth in Iowa**

- **Complex Needs**: Behavioral challenges often accompany intellectual disabilities, severe aggression, sexual acting out behaviors and severe mental health conditions.
  - These challenges make their care particularly intensive and demanding.
- **Placement Disruptions**: Youth bounce between placements, worsening trauma and outcomes.
- Lack of In-State Care: Too many youth are sent out of state due to inadequate facilities.

# The Solution: Invest in Iowa's Youth

#### **1. Support Workforce Development**

- Increase reimbursement rates to attract and retain qualified staff.
- Provide evidence-based training to enhance care quality.

#### 2. Modernize Facilities

- Upgrade outdated structures to meet modern safety and therapeutic standards.
- Include measures like delayed-lock doors, alarms, advanced security systems and locked facilities.

#### 3. Strengthen Iowa's Behavioral Health System

- Reduce reliance on out-of-state placements.
- Create stable, evidence-based environments for youth.
